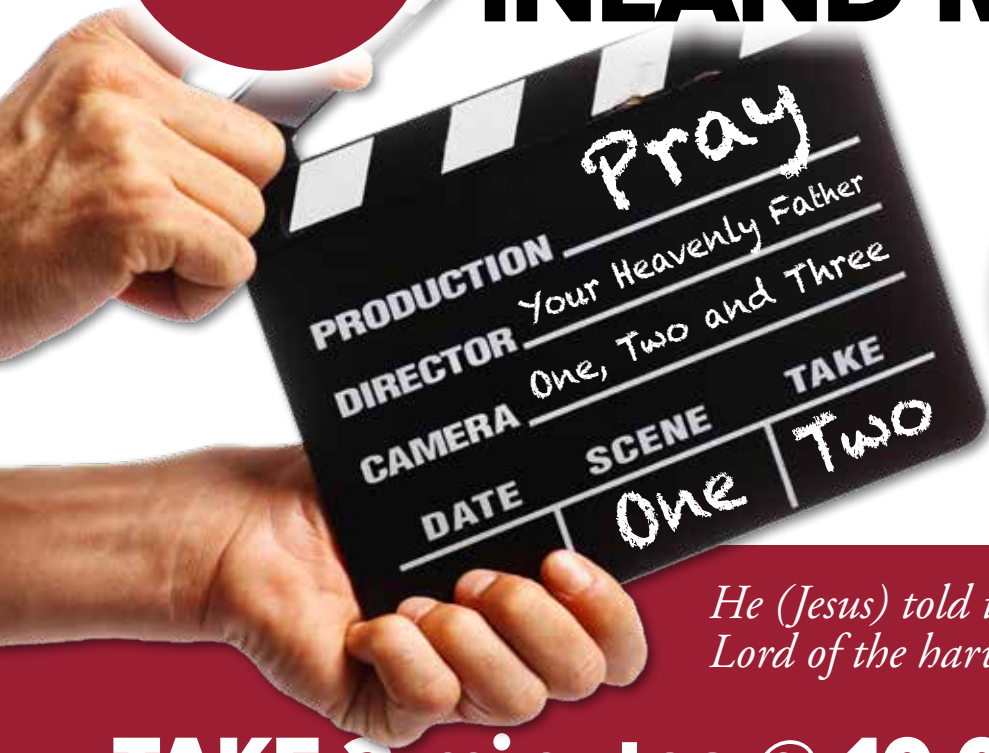

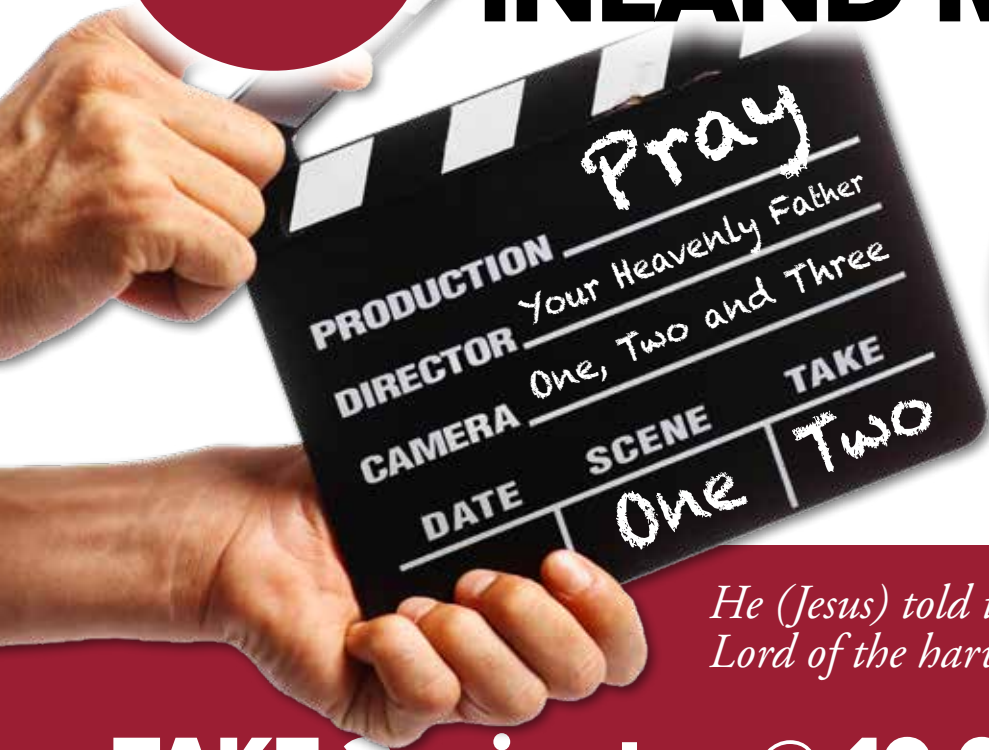

Ask that more churches will commit to sharing the Gospel with them. vimeo.com/261015195 (3 mins video)	Alagwa of Tanzania 3 i They believe they are still living under the curse of Noah's son Ham. Ask for more Gospel workers to show how Jesus has lifted all curses for those who trust in Him.	Antakarana of Madagascar 4 i Have mixed ethnic ancestry and a blend of animistic and Islamic beliefs. Ask for more Gospel workers for the current team. vimeo.com/176598384 (6.75 mins video)	Antandroy of Madagascar 5 i Their name means 'where there are thorns'. Ask the Lord to send more Gospel workers who will bring Jesus' living water.	Antanosy of Madagascar 6 i Many claim Christianity as their religion but have a limited understanding. Ask for Gospel workers who will bring clarity.
Arabs of North Africa 7 i The Arabs of North Africa are Islamic. Ask for Christian workers and business people to go and share the Gospel.	Bara of Madagascar 8 i Traditionally cattle people, although this is changing with the discovery of sapphires in the area. Ask for Gospel workers who will be true jewels reflecting the brilliance of the Gospel.	Berbers of North Africa 9 i This is the original people group across North Africa. St Augustine was a Berber. Ask for Gospel workers who are able to maintain and share their faith in a Muslim context, and have medical, business, or other skills to contribute an enterprise to the community.	Theological Educators 10 i Are still needed to help train the African church leaders in theology and mission. Ask for more godly theological educators who are willing to teach in Africa, and have a passion for building up African leaders through sound instruction.	Borana of Kenya 11 i A Cushite people related to the Gabbra, Sakuye and Rendille. The Borana Christians are evangelising their own people. Praise God! Ask that God would continue to empower the Borana Christians to share the Good News among the Borana and other tribes.	Chadian Arabs 12 i 12 tribal groupings among these people. Ask for more Gospel workers who are committed to living in harsh locations, are patient in prayer, committed to language learning, and persistent in sharing the Good News.	Datooga of Tanzania 13 i Are generally proud of their culture and see no reason to change. However, there are some who have attended Bible school. Ask that they would be strong in the Lord and anointed in evangelism. Ask for more Gospel workers who will declare the good changes available in Christ.
Didinga of South Sudan 14 i AIM has had ministry 'on and off' with this animistic people group since 2006. An AIM Focus Team, with a number of Aussie members is re-establishing the work there. Please pray for them and ask for more Gospel workers for this people group.	Digo of Kenya and Tanzania 15 i This coastal group has traditionally been very resistant to the Gospel, but there are indications that this is now changing. Ask for more Gospel workers who are persistent in their commitment to bring the Light to the Digo.	Dorobo of Kenya and Tanzania 16 i This is the second UPG who are now considered reached under AIM's 2020 Vision strategy. Praise God! Ask for more Dorobo who are willing to take the Good News to other San-origin people, and to other tribes. vimeo.com/237551577 (8.5 mins video)	Fulani of West Africa 17 i Were the first group in West Africa to convert to Islam. Ask for more Gospel workers to share the message of the Prince of Peace with this large (20,000,000), widely dispersed (over 9 African countries) people group. vimeo.com/243101308 (2.5 mins video)	Gabbra of Kenya 18 i Believe in a merciless justice, where grace is unknown and wrongs are righted by payment. Islam is growing in this area. Ask for Gospel workers who will communicate that Jesus has paid the price that covers all wrongdoing when we trust in Him.	Gujarati of Madagascar 19 i Muslims from India, the Gujarati are mostly businessmen who have a significant stake in the economy. Ask for Gospel workers who will show that true riches can only be found in Christ.	African Mobilisation 20 i Africa's contribution to world mission is growing. AIM is helping mobilise Africans for mission. Ask God to continue to raise up more African workers for His African Harvest. vimeo.com/291087015 (2.5 mins video)
Ik/Teus of Uganda 21 i Are a small people group who have struggled to live in harsh conditions. Ask for more Gospel workers who will show that 'the last will be first' and the 'meek will inherit the earth' through Christ. vimeo.com/297252488 (3 mins video)	Islanders of the Indian Ocean 22 i Nearly all are Muslims. Some of the 'postcard' locations are undermined with poor infrastructure. Ask for Gospel workers who will be willing to demonstrate God's love as well as verbally sharing the Good News.	Kachipo of South Sudan 23 i The Gospel of Mark is being translated now. Pray for God's hand on the translation team, and for more workers to teach Mark's Gospel.	Kanembu of Chad 24 i This people was once a powerful dynasty and most of Chad's current merchants are from this people group. Ask for Gospel workers who are willing to live in an isolated area and who know some French.	Karamojong of Uganda 25 i Half the population of this animistic people group are under 18 years old. There are two Kiwis and one Aussie on teams currently working among them. Ask for more Gospel workers on teams committed to discipleship and Bible teaching.	Laarim of South Sudan 26 i The existing ministry team has seen fruit in this work and wants to maintain the momentum. Ask for Gospel workers who have skills such as healthcare, veterinary, education, to form a platform for their ministry. vimeo.com/265007510 (4.25 mins video)	Lokwa of South Sudan 27 i Believe in a spiritual being for whom every household must build a small shrine. Ask for Gospel workers who will bring the true Light to the Lokwa.
Lopit of South Sudan 28 i Believe in a supreme being and the spiritual sphere. There is a Kiwi on this team, ask for more Gospel workers who have healthcare, veterinary, or education skills that would provide platforms for outreach.	Maba of Chad 29 i One the largest non-Arab tribes in Chad. Long ago the Maba overthrew the Christian Tunjur dynasty in Wadai and formed the backbone of the Islamic Wadai Empire. Ask for Gospel workers who will bring the Kingdom of God to the Maba.	Mahafaly of Madagascar 30 i Have developed skills to live in an inhospitable land. They are fishermen. ⛔ Ask God to send them 'fishers of men' and that the Nahara will receive and share the Good News.	Makwe of Mozambique 3 i Although mostly Muslim, most cling to Animistic beliefs. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who radiate God's Light and for receptive hearts among the Makwe.	Matumbi of Tanzania 4 i Staged the Maji-Maji Rebellion (1905-07) against German colonial rulers, who had forced many Matumbi into slavery. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who will demonstrate the true freedom found as slaves to Christ.
Mbororo of Central African Republic 5 i Are related to the Fulani and are semi-nomadic. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who will show them the Way. vimeo.com/314206172 (3.5 mins video)	Mwani of Mozambique 6 i Are well-known herbalists and feared black magicians. ⛔ Ask God to send good practitioners of His Word who will turn the people from fear to Truth.	Short-Term Service 7 i Not everyone is called to serve God long-term among unreached people groups, or not straight away. ⛔ Ask the Lord to also call those whom he wants to serve short-term, to either support existing workers, and/or to lay a foundation for future missionary service. vimeo.com/252882776 (2.5 mins video)	Ndau of Mozambique 8 i Are well-known herbalists and feared black magicians. ⛔ Ask God to send good practitioners of His Word who will turn the people from fear to Truth.	Ndengereko of Tanzania 9 i Claim to be Islamic, but will turn first to their animistic traditions in times of trouble. ⛔ Ask for more workers to plant more churches among the Ndengereko.	Nyamwezi of Tanzania 10 i Known as the 'People of the Moon'. There are already two Aussies on this ministry team, which partners with an Africa Inland Church team. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who have skills such as farming, community health, teaching; and those who are able to teach theology and Muslim outreach.	Nyang'atom of South Sudan 11 i Animists who are very conscious of the spirit world. ⛔ Ask for workers who will guide them to be receptive to God's Spirit.
O of Kenya 12 i The Jesus film is being translated into the O language. ⛔ Pray for workers who can share this gospel video with the O people.	Rangi of Tanzania 13 i Traditional religious beliefs have been incorporated into both the Islam and Catholicism of the Rangi. ⛔ Baptisms are taking place, but more workers are needed to proclaim the Gospel and make disciples.	Rendille of Kenya 14 i The Rendille received the New Testament in their own language last year. Praise God! ⛔ Ask for more Gospel workers who will continue to proclaim God's Word.	Sakalava of Madagascar 15 i Lay Mazava' is a local song all about the Light of Christ, so pray that His Light would shine as they play this song. ⛔ Ask for more workers to sound His Song. vimeo.com/176599354 (10.5 mins video)	Samburu of Kenya 16 i The first UPG who are now classified as reached under AIM's 2020 Vision strategy. Praise God! ⛔ Ask the Lord to continue to establish Christ-centred churches among the Samburu, and for Samburu believers to continue to share the Good News beyond their own tribe. vimeo.com/190216331 (6 mins video)	San of Namibia 17 i Are the Kalahari Bushmen. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who will be committed to these people long term, and who also have skills that are useful to the San, such as experience with livestock, tutoring, arid farming and community health work.	Training in Mission 18 i Most Gospel workers need training in missions. ⛔ Ask the Lord to equip workers on all levels for long-term service. vimeo.com/159842455 (2.75 mins video)
Sandawe of Tanzania 19 i '...when the rains come, we pray for a good harvest of crops... and we continue to pray for more workers for the harvest... especially pastors and evangelists. We are excited that new churches are being planted but they need mature believers to give leadership.' ⛔ Ask for more pastors and evangelists to work among the Sandawe.	Somali of the Horn 20 i A Muslim people group who are spread over the African Horn, and in a number of countries around the world. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who have medical skills, or small enterprise skills for Horn ministry, and ask for Gospel workers to reach Somalis in the African diaspora.	South Asians of East Africa 21 i Many Indians came as labourers in the late 1800s and stayed on, many are successful in business. ⛔ Ask for workers who will show that true riches are found in Christ.	Swahili Arab 22 i Almost 100% Muslim, with very few believers. ⛔ Ask for workers who will persevere in reaching this group. Pray for the Good News to break through the spiritual resistance.	Swahili Bantu 23 i Emerged after Bantu tribes were invaded and intermarried with Arab traders. ⛔ Ask for more Gospel workers and for spiritual breakthrough.	Men of Mission 24 i Men are under-represented in mission. ⛔ Ask the Lord to call more men to His harvest field. vimeo.com/180296915 (3 mins video)	Tanala of Madagascar 25 i Believe that there are spirits all around us in nature that need to be appeased. ⛔ Ask for workers who will testify about God's Spirit, and for many to respond in faith.
Toposa of South Sudan 26 i Believe that when the Murle and Didinga arrived they took the gazelle meat and left only soup for the Toposa. ⛔ Ask for workers who will demonstrate the forgiveness and equality available through Christ.	Tsimihety of Madagascar 27 i Their name means 'those who do not cut their hair' which was a sign of refusal to recognise authority. ⛔ Ask for workers who will demonstrate equality through Christ (and His authority).	Tuareg of the Sahara Desert 28 i Are a Berber people scattered throughout Algeria, Libya, Mali, Niger, and Burkina Faso. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who are willing to endure hardship to reach these people.	Support Workers 29 i Gospel workers serving on the front line need support workers. ⛔ Ask the Lord to send more workers who will serve in support roles (eg teaching MK kids, administration, etc). vimeo.com/218918199 (1.5 mins video)	Y refugees of the Horn 30 i You would be unlikely to find another culture to match the Y in hospitality and showing honour. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who will surpass the Y in generosity and grace, demonstrating God's love.	Zaramo of Tanzania 31 i Fear the powers of darkness, evil spirits and curses. ⛔ Ask for Gospel workers who will shine God's Light, Holy Spirit and blessings.	Zigua of Tanzania June 1 i Islam is the primary religion, often mixed with traditional African beliefs. Some have chosen to follow Christ. ⛔ Ask for more Gospel workers to disciple the Zigua believers and reach more with the Good News.
