Note 1

Project & Field Worker Funds

Project & Field Worker Funds are balances held under obligations with projects and field worker agreements for such items as emergency travel, resettlement, and current balances to be disbursed.

Statement of Accounting Policies

The Africa Inland Mission is an incorporated charitable trust under the Charitable Trust Act 1957.

General Accounting Policies

Africa Inland Mission has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Particular Accounting Policies

The following particular accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of earnings and the financial position have been applied.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

Fixed Assets

There are no fixed assets.

Going Concern

The nature of the organisation is that it is reliant on the continued support of its members and funding bodies. The management is confident of receiving this ongoing support, and accordingly has adopted the going concern assumption, in the preparation of these financial statements.

Revenue Recognition & Project Balances

General donations with no specified purpose are recognised in income when receipted. Donations specified for either a field worker, or a project are classified as income when received. Any unremitted specified donations are transferred to revenue reserves, less any applicable administration fees.

Income Tax Exemption

Section CW41 & 42 of the Income Tax Act 2007 exempt income tax, on an organisation registered with the Charities Commission, and applying income to it's charitable purposes. The Trust has Income Tax Exemption and Charitable status through it's registration with the Charities Commission on the 9th April 2015 [CC51835].
