Serve, Support, and Disciple: More than a century ago, Africa Inland Mission planted a church in DR Congo that today, despite the nation's decades of rebellion, war, dictatorship, ethnic violence, and famine, is over a million members strong. While thriving in some areas, the church in other regions still faces significant challenges.
