

Today, hundreds of Africa's unique ethnic people groups remain **unreached** – that's over 300 million people with no viable witness to the gospel. Africa Inland Mission **serves**, **equips**, **and helps mobilise churches and believers from the global Church** to advance the gospel among Africans who have the least opportunity to hear about Jesus.

United by Christ's love, we welcome labourers from many nations and cultures to step out into cross-cultural ministry and find their place in the Great Commission. Wherever we minister, we follow the model and teaching of Jesus as we walk in humility, build relationships, embrace learner attitudes, and strive to live as belongers in our communities. We serve on diverse teams, and in collaboration with varied ministry partners, giving testimony to the truth and beauty of the Body of Christ.

Our passion is to see the worship of Jesus Christ spread among Africans around the globe – through individual lives fully committed to him, and collectively through Christ-centred churches.

We welcome labourers from many nations and cultures to step out into cross-cultural ministry and find their place in the Great Commission.

Africa Inland Mission has been leading people into meaningful ministry for over 125 years, but the work is far from finished. As we press on, we also lean into the critical task of mobilising, equipping, training, and sending local **African believers and missionaries** toward this great calling, and we continue to **adapt and embrace creative ways** to bring the message of Christ to an ever-changing world.

WHAT IS SHORT TERM

Short Term placements (up to one year) are a great way to serve, learn and grow your vision for cross-cultural mission, especially if you are considering the possibility of Long Term service.

Individual Short Term placements help fulfil Long Term ministry goals as you serve alongside Long Term missionaries, in a variety of pioneering ministries, or enabling and support roles.

Short Term training teams offer 'on the job' missions training with experienced missionaries for those preparing for Long Term. Our GO program is three months and INBOUND runs for one year.

WHAT'S INVOLVED

Our Short Term placements are open to born-again Christians with an active growing relationship with the Lord Jesus, who agree with our Statement of Faith and are over 18 years of age. To join our Short Term volunteers you must also have a positive recommendation from your church leaders and complete our application process including an acceptance interview.

Once we've worked out your placement, we'll provide a budget for your costs, arrange attendance at our Home Based Orientation, and assist in the preparations needed to serve in Africa. We'll also arrange a debrief after the placement.

WHAT IS LONG TERM


If you're willing to commit from two years to your entire career working towards reaching Africa's remaining unreached peoples, there are hundreds of opportunities to serve with AIM across the Muslim North, West and Sub-Saharan Africa, and also with the African diaspora outside of Africa.

From church planting teams, immersing yourself in local communities, language and culture; to role specific ministries to help train and equip African churches; discipleship through vocation; or in a vital support role, your gifts, skills and passion to share the good news of Jesus and make disciples can be well used.

WHAT'S INVOLVED

To become a full member of AIM and serve Long Term you will go through a thorough and detailed application process in partnership with your church leadership. The application journey is designed so together we can discern this is God's call for you (and your family), and ensure you are appropriately equipped to begin your missionary service with AIM.

AIM have a set of minimum Bible Requirements and other training requirements and you'll need to answer these questions: Do you have a personal growing relationship with the Lord Jesus? Are you actively involved with a local church community? Are you seeking to share the gospel and disciple others? Are you willing to raise your own financial and prayer support?



Who we are looking for...

The missionary life is a less-travelled path for a reason. It's challenging and humbling work. But Jesus' call remains: to join him in his mission to seek and save the lost; to step out in obedience, into the unknown, into the unexpected. **This is an extraordinary call – meant for ordinary people like you.**



The church is primarily responsible for sending missionaries, so AIM will only send you in partnership with your home church. They know you best and carry an ongoing pastoral responsibility for you as part of their local body, even as you are sent to serve away from home.

We love to serve and work in partnership with churches who share our heart and vision for God's glory to be made known among all peoples and share a priority to reach the unreached.

Where we work

In 1895 AIM's founders left Mombasa on the Kenyan coast with a vision to push *Inland* - to places and peoples where the gospel had not yet reached - and plant mission stations across the continent to Lake Chad.

Today, AIM works in over 20 African countries and among African diaspora communities around the world through our *borderless* ministries, with the same heart and purpose of taking the gospel to those who are still unreached and have little if any opportunity to hear about Jesus.

AIM missionaries can be found in busy urban cities and rural hard-toreach locations, across five 'receiving' regions.

Our Asia-Pacific Region, with offices in Australia and Hong Kong, works with churches across the whole region to send missionaries to serve among Africa's unreached.
