There are over 6,000+ unreached people groups that are located in countries that don't allow traditional missionaries access. These countries might appear closed to missionaries, but they are open for business. If we are going to finish the Great Commission, then many of the next generation of missionaries will have to either start businesses or take jobs to gain access.

Objectives:

You will receive training in maintaining a Christian witness, church planting, developing a professional identity, BAM, cultural awareness and be mentored by experienced missionaries.

Practicing evangelism as part of a church planting team, visiting existing BAMs, planning a business using the *BAM 360 26-step Business Planning Tool*, engaging daily in N Africa community, daily Arabic classes and trips to various cities across the country.
