Kampala Inbound: a 12-month Training Team



Kampala Inbound is a 12-month program designed to train new missionaries to thrive in cross-cultural ministry, preparing them for long-term service.

Teams are mentored by experienced missionaries and work in partnership with a local church as they learn culture and local religion, language-learning skills, the dynamics of teamwork and church partnerships, and essential communication skills for future ministry.

Based in Kampala Uganda, team members live in largely Muslim urban neighborhoods with exposure to a vast diversity of people groups and religious backgrounds. Team members also experience a variety of ministry settings through field site visits, getting a true feel for what future missionary service might look like.

This program is designed for singles, couples, and families without school-age children. The program is for learners who have a heart for future long-term ministry in Africa.
