Since 1991, Africa Inland Mission (AIM) and Wycliffe Bible Translators International (WBTI) have worked cooperatively to provide counselling and support services for missionaries at Tumaini Counselling Centre in Nairobi, Kenya. "Tumaini," from the Swahili word for hope, is the name of the facility that houses the support teams of AIM, WBTI, and associate counsellors. Tumaini Kampala is a branch of Tumaini Nairobi.

How to Find Us

Tumaini Counselling Centre is located in Lubowa, a residential community on the south side of Kampala. From Kampala *turn left* off Entebbe Road just <u>before</u> "Roofings". From Entebbe / Kajjansi *turn right* off Entebbe Road just <u>after</u> "Roofings".

Follow this road up until you pass the Joint Clinical Research Centre (JCRC) on your right; *turn on your right* immediately after the JCRC gate. Drive up this road, passing Quality Supermarket, a large field and the International School of Uganda (all on your left). Continue on this road, passing by the road on your left (dirt/marram, downhill) and on your right (paved/tarmac, uphill). We are located in the 3rd compound on your right after passing these 2 roads. The gate is green and see-through and there are many palm trees. **Tumaini Kampala is the first apartment on your left as you enter the lower building.**
